APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

Society of Clinical Research Professionals Malaysia (formerly known as Association of Clinical Research Professionals Malaysia (ACRPM), hereinafter known as SCRPM) values and respects member's right to retain the privacy of certain Personal Information. CONSENT

SCRPM's Collection of Personal Information

Also, the SCRPM might collect Aggregate Information for research purposes^[1].

SCRPM's Use of Personal Information

The Personal Information collected by the SCRPM is used for the following purposes:

- to contact the individual/member for instruction;
